

Consumption of Alcohol Policy

- 1. The Combined Counties League acknowledges that all football clubs serving alcohol on match days have a responsibility to ensure that match participants and spectators are able to enjoy their football without hindrance from alcohol-related incidents. To ensure that this is the case the following policy must be adhered to by all members.
- 2. NO alcohol, or any drinks (alcoholic or otherwise) in glass bottles, or glasses, should be allowed immediately adjacent to the pitch itself where they could be used to cause damage or personal injury.
- 3. Consumption of alcohol can be allowed in grounds where there is a designated area provided, such as an outside patio, so long as there is a clear boundary to indicate where the area ends, and it is not within the immediate vicinity of the pitch.
 - Such an area must be clearly signed and, if necessary, stewarded on match days to ensure compliance.
- 4. Members failing to comply with this policy will be dealt with by the competition.
